Tell the World How Important the Earth Is to You!

Students in grades K-12, who reside in Vallejo are eligible to enter the Earth Day Poster Contest. Entries are due by April 10, 2019.

HOW DO I ENTER?

Entries will be accepted Monday, April 8, 2019 through Wednesday, April 10, 2019. NO later than 5:15p.m. each day.

Entries should be dropped off at City Hall, 555 Santa Clara St. to the Public Works Department (4th Floor), Vallejo, CA.

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES & ENTRY GUIDELINES

What are the rules?

- No entry fee or purchase necessary.
- Open to public, private and home-schooled youths grades K through 12 in the City of Vallejo area.
- City of Vallejo or Sponsoring Employees are not eligible to participate

WHAT DO I WIN?

There will be 1st (\$200), 2nd (\$100) & 3rd (\$50) winners, one for each category (K-2nd), (3rd grade -6th grade), (7th grade -12th grade). Honorable Mentions (\$25)

WHAT ARE THE POSTER CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES?

To be eligible, each entrant must submit an image or design for the poster contest along with a completed entry form. Entry must be submitted to City Hall, Public Works Department (4th Floor) 555 Santa Clara St. Vallejo, CA.

Entry must be depicting one of the following Earth Day themes:

Conserve Natural Resources - Reduce Global Warming - Stormwater - Renewable Energy - Composting - Don't Pollute - Fuel Cells - Building Green - Conserve Energy - Protect Your Environment - Endangered Animals - Alternate Energy - Reuse, Reduce, Recycle - Earth Day Every Day - Wise Water Use - Waste Free Lunches - *or any current topic pertaining to the environment.*

Entries cannot contain any material that is defamatory or offensive to any person. Entrants work cannot violate intellectual property, privacy, publicity or other proprietary rights of a person or company.

- To be eligible, the students' parent/legal guardian must assign all copyright and other rights in the poster entry to the sponsors by signing the application form. On submission, art work becomes the property of the sponsors, non-winners will have their artwork returned to them upon request after the judging; however, winning artwork becomes property of the City.
- Each artist may submit one poster. More than one poster may be submitted per family. All entries must be entrant's original work, and the entry must be the work of an individual artist.
- Entries are to be drawn in color, using pencils, crayons, markers, ink and paint or created using original computer graphics in PDF format.
- Entries cannot use trademarks or company logos, computer-generated artwork, traced images, pages from coloring books, or from Internet websites.
- Hard copy entries must be on paper measuring 12 inches by 18 inches or smaller but not larger.
- All pictures should be HORIZONTAL (Landscape).

HOW ARE THE WINNERS SELECTED AND NOTIFIED?

An independent panel will judge the artwork anonymously. All judges' decisions are final. Winning entrants will be notified via phone and email no later than April 18, 2019. Prizes will be awarded at the Earth Day Event on April 20, 2019. Winning entrants agree and acknowledge that their name, school and grade will be available for public distribution, including possible placement on the Internet websites of the sponsoring organizations. By accepting the prize, each winner agrees that the sponsors may post the winner's name on a list of winners, and may use winner's name, poster and school information for the purpose of program promotion without further compensation.
